SAMUEL MANN, being duly sworn, deposes and says, that he resides at No. 299 West 12th Street, New York 14, New York, and that he is the petitioner in the above-entitled proceeding.

That the petition for the probate of the above-named decedent's last will and testament that said deceased was, at the time of her death, a resident of the County of New York, and departed this life at 78 Waterside Lane, Clinton, Connecticut, on the 25th day of July, 1951, leaving personal property within the County of New York.

Prior to November 1st, 1949 decedent resided continuously in New York County for more than thirty years, her last residence being at 21 Claremont Avenue, New York. She and her sister had been members of the faculty of Teachers College, Columbia University, New York, and upon their retirement in 1935 from the faculty they continued to maintain their residence in New York County. In October, 1949, the decedent, being then ill and over the age of seventy-five years, decided to move to her summer cottage at Clinton, Connecticut, which she had inherited in 1946 from her sister, in the hope that her health would improve. There being no other members of her family who resided with her she surrendered possession of her apartment here and went to Clinton on or about November 1st, 1949. With the exception, how-

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ever, of certain household furniture decedent left all her personal property in New York County. Her income continued to be deposited in a New York bank, and until the date of her death she paid United States income taxes to the Collector of Internal Revenue, Third District, New York. She never registered for voting purposes in Clinton and maintained no bank account there. She engaged in no business or other activities in Connecticut, and with the exception of the summer cottage and the furnishings therein left no property in the State of Connecticut. Deponent acted as her counsel for twelve years preceding the date of her death, and at no time after November 1st, 1949 did the decedent by word, act or deed regard herself as other than a resident and citizen of New York.
