A None.

Q Did she ever have or adopt any?
A No.

Q What was her father's name?
A Anton J. Altenhofen.

Q Is he living?
A No.

Q Did he die before Corinne?
A Yes.

Q How many times was he married?
A Once.

Q To whom?
A Louise.

Q Is she living?
A Yes.

Q How many times was she married?
A Once.

Q How many children were born to the parents?

A Two.

Q One was Corinne -- name the other.

Q Is she living? A Yes.

Q She is over eighteen and married to whom?

A John K., deceased.

Q Two children are all that were born to the parents of Corinne? A Yes.

Q Two children are all that were ever born to her mother? A Yes.
